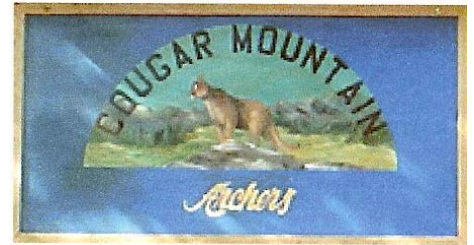

## WOODLAKE TWO DAY SHOOT

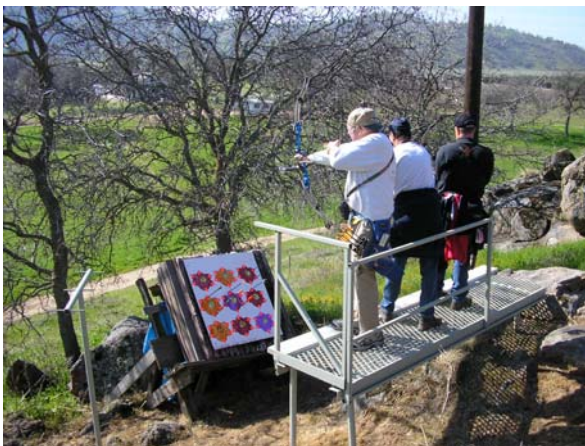
March 3 & 4
