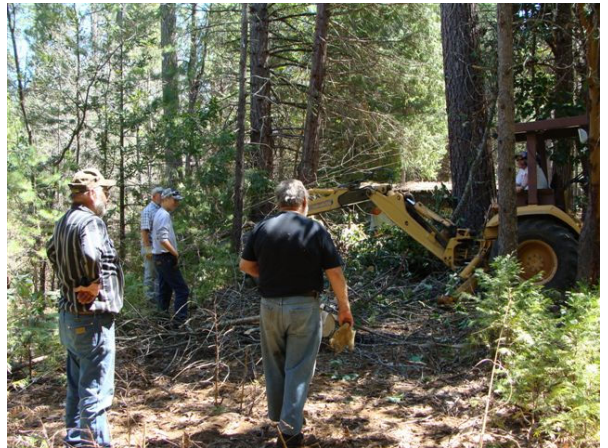
President's Message (Continued from page 1)

1. SO YOU WANT TO BE A BOWHUNTER
2. YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES AS A BOWHUNTER

4. WHEN TO SHOOT, WHERE TO AIM
5. THE HUNT
6. WHAT IF...?
7. FIELD EXPERIENCES--- equipment inspections, shooting, blood trailing & game recovery, tree stand use, map & compass use.
8. COURSE COMPLETION.

California Department of Fish & Game and the California Bowmen Hunters & State Archery Assoc. recommend that every archer become certified through this program before bowhunting. Many states require this course certificate prior to bowhunting in their state.

Any students also in need of a California Hunter Education Certificate, that is also possible with an additional 7 hours class time on another agreed upon date and an additional \$10 class fee.
