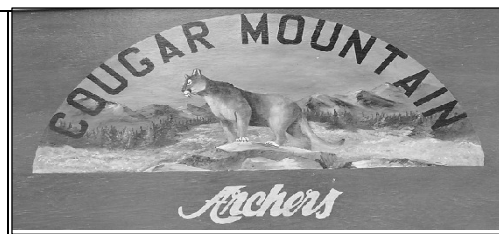

Turkey Season is still open. Following the general spring turkey season will be another couple of weeks when you will be able to harvest bearded birds with your archery equipment only.

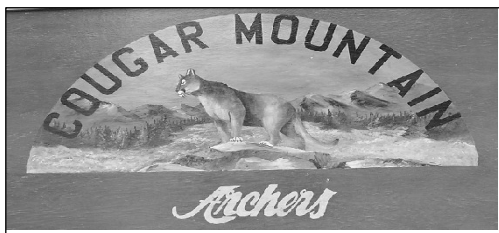
During your time in the outdoors hunting turkeys, DFG should have published our 2011 Mammal and Fur bearers regulations and drawing information. So each of us are able to purchase our new Hunting Licenses for 2011 and tag applications of each specie we desire to hunt this summer, fall and winter in California. Remember your applications will need to be mailed in May.

This year DFG will finally after several years of promises get their Automated License Purchase System in operation for Hunting Licenses. Please do not wait until deadline dates or the day you desire to fish or hunt to learn how this new system is going to work.

It is a computer, and all should know after we have lived with them for several years now. They have a mind of their own, and sometimes cause many heartaches.

If you do not have an International Bowhunter Education Program Certificate, and may desire to attempt harvesting an animal with your bow in one of the Mandatory Bowhunter Education states or countries. Or if you are a new bowhunter and just learning about bowhunting. A class will be held in Paradise on June 25th and 26th at the Becker (your editor) Residence the first day and at the Paradise Bowhunters Range second day.
