You may still have one day to get your Hunting Applications to DFG. Deadline is June 2nd.

Go to <u>California Outdoor Heritage Alliance</u> on web, (<u>http://www.outdoorheritage.org/</u>) for current information on Proposed law changes in California. After getting their website, click on <u>State of Affairs</u>, and you will be able to read the latest information. What I place in this newsletter may be outdated by time you would read and act on. Thus by each person checking for legislative needs we will be on time.

They represent CBH/SAA and many other Hunting & Fishing Organizations here in California. Best lobbyist group sportsman have had for many years. Check out their website they are indeed friends of yours as outdoor people themselves.

Pasted below is a current proposed bill which will affect each of us most likely.

AB 809 (Feuer) - Long Gun Registration - OPPOSE

AB 809 (Feuer/D-Los Angeles) proposes to expand the current handgun registration law to include all long guns by requiring the Attorney General to permanently maintain a registry of all firearms purchasers.

Under the bill's provisions, those who purchase or transfer a shotgun or rifle would be required to register that firearm by submitting their name, address, place of birth, phone number and occupation to the California Department of Justice.

At this point, it is unclear whether or not California's existing handgun registration law is helping to fight crime in any meaningful way. COHA believes it is unnecessary to greatly expand the handgun registration law to include all firearms - particularly given that traditional sporting arms make up a very small fraction of all firearms related homicides in California each year.

COHA is working with CWA and other sporting interests to defeat this unnecessary and intrusive legislation. AB 809 is currently in the Assembly Committee on Appropriations. Assembly Appropriations Committee
